Staying Connected During COVID-19

I have been keeping the parishioners of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in my prayers during this pandemic. I can't even imagine the difficulties you must be facing; balancing family, job, school and everything else that has been made more complicated by COVID-19. During this stress-filled time, I want you to know that our parish continues to care for the spiritual and material needs of our faith community.

Once our church building was closed in March, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish began to stream Masses, devotions and informational updates to our parishioners via our website and through our social media and YouTube channel, Operation Safe Mode. Operation Safe Mode has presented more than 100 episodes that included Sacred Sunday Mass, updates and alerts, as well as entertainment and educational opportunities. We have also posted daily reflections on social media, so that everyone could remain focused on the daily readings and the challenge of the Catholic Faith in the face of COVID-19. We also reached out via the Seton Chronicles electronic newsletter.

We created a Ministry of Hospitality and also did the monthly hard mailings to our households with special "remembrances" in each mailing. We also, once our church building opened, created volunteer cleaning crews to sanitize the church and restrooms after each use.

Capital Improvements

Your contributions to our parish help to maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community. In the three years that I have been the pastor we have made a significant amount of capital improvements to our campus. In that time we have sold our old office building and built a new parish office and parish center on the campus near our church. The church, itself, received a facelift as well. The exterior trim board around the church's façade, and all of the light poles, were painted. The lights, themselves, were upgraded to a more efficient LED system, providing energy savings and better illumination. The roof on the church was replaced, as well as the ceiling tile in the vestibule, which was badly stained from water damage. The sanctuary and baptismal areas were also refinished and the interior walls were painted to brighten up the walls that were never painted since the opening of the building.

New lights were also added to the sanctuary to illuminate the altar, presiders chair and the tabernacle. The social hall was also upgraded with dividers for formation classroom privacy.

Money Counters

These individuals assist in counting collections.

Ministry to the Homebound

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion take Communion to the sick and homebound, who are encouraged to receive the sacrament, even if they cannot attend Mass.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

Parishioners assist the priest in distributing the Eucharist at Mass.

Religious Formation Leaders and Youth Ministry Leaders

These individuals assist in forming the next generation of Christ's Disciples.

Lectors

Lectors proclaim the Word of God during Mass or other liturgical functions. Lectors devote time to preparation and understanding of sacred Scripture.

Greeters

Greeters welcome Parishioners to our faith community.

Ushers

The ushers take up the offertory and distribute bulletins after Mass. They also assist as needed with emergencies and other concerns.

Ministry of Care

These volunteers provide pastoral care to the sick and homebound of the parish. The ministers take the Eucharist to the sick where they are at home, a personal care home or a nursing home.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

We are looking for volunteers to help lead the Children's Liturgy of the Word, which is held during each of the weekend Masses. The commitment is minimal and all materials are provided.

Christian Mothers

The Confraternity of Christian Mothers is a women's group dedicated to the Sorrowful Virgin, that nurtures and fosters the values that spring from Catholic social teaching. Through service and activities, these values are brought to life by dedicated women of all ages.
