

Words of Faith from Father Jim

Tips for your daily Rosary and (The method of Spiritual Muscle Confusion!)

The Rosary isn't just a prayer we say — it's an organized prayer time to contemplate the life of Jesus. While we say the *Hail Mary's*, our minds are meant to stay with the mystery we're reflecting on. This is called mental prayer.

One way to pray this well is to let the $Hail\ Mary's$ become like a quiet rhythm or chant that surrounds your thoughts. The steady pace of the words can help you stay centered as you picture each mystery — It's like the prayer gives spiritually protective structure to your reflection.

If you pray more than one Rosary a day, here's something to keep in mind: you don't have to always stick to the next set of mysteries in order. For example, on a Tuesday you might pray the Sorrowful Mysteries in the morning, but in the evening, you could choose the mysteries that come to your heart in no particular order with 5 total mysteries making a second (5 decade) rosary (once you have them memorized) — maybe the Wedding Feast at Cana, the Descent of the Holy Spirit, the Annunciation, the Coronation of Mary, and The Birth of our Lord. Why is that good?

There is a term in exercise called *muscle confusion* that forces your muscles to grow by not getting too used to the exact same order of exercise everyday. Your muscles *have to* grow to adapt to the unexpected exercise they may need to perform each day without predictability. Apply this same principal to the Mysteries of the Rosary. I call it *Spiritual Muscle Confusion*, and it helps force me to contemplate the mysteries of the Rosary more fruitfully, so that my spiritual muscles may grow! It works! Doing this also allows the Holy Spirit to serve a mystery to you. Some days, certain mysteries extracted from the entire rosary set of options may speak to what's going on in your life. This makes prayer more personal and keeps your attention fresh. It's a good mix of structure and freedom — the discipline of the Rosary with the openness of the Spirit. I like to keep one Rosary fixed as scheduled for the day and one 5 decade rosary with mixed and matched mysteries later for my spiritual muscle confusion!

"Helping Others in Need"

This holiday season we will have several opportunities to help others in need in our community. There are currently 135 families who depend on help from our SVDP Foodbank to help feed their families. With the current government shut down, funds are limited to help programs such as the Food bank. God has asked us to make use of our time, talent and treasury to help others in need and during this upcoming holiday season, we ask that you share some of your blessings with others. Here is how you can help —

November – donations of paper products such as paper towels, Kleenex tissues and toilet paper will be collected and distributed to families as needed. Donations can be placed in the back of the church or dropped off at the Seton Parish Center during business hours. Paper products are not eligible to be purchased with food stamps and your donation will greatly help these families stretch their dollars.

December - we will once again sponsor the Holiday Dinner Tote collection for the 135 families. Sign up sheets will be placed in the back of church or contact the Parish Office at 724-864-6364 and sign up for how many bags you will be able to donate. You are asked to purchase a reusable shopping tote (.99 cents) and fill it with non-perishable items that the family can use towards their holiday meal. Items such as instant potatoes, canned vegetables, box of holiday cookies, coffee/tea/hot cocoa, applesauce, holiday napkins, candy are examples, and include any items that you enjoy at your holiday dinner. The tote bags will need to be brought to Mack Hall of St Eliz Ann Seton on Dec 8, 9 or 10th (remember Dec 8th is a holiday so you will be coming to mass and can drop it off). All bags must be dropped off by Dec 10th to

`ensure we have enough for all families. Please be sure to use a reusable shopping tote and not a plastic bag. The tote is easy for distributing to the families and for them to carry to their car.






