

Words of Faith from Father Jim

A 150-Day Scripture Journey (The Psalms, Gospels, Acts, and Isaiah)

If you've ever wanted a simple and steady way to stay rooted in God's Word each day, try my plan (The 150 day cycle) This plan offers a prayerful rhythm that unfolds beautifully over 150 days. I plan to repeat it each 150 days as a sweet routine to anchor my day in God's word. It begins with the prayers of the Psalms, moves through the life and ministry of Christ in the Gospels, continues with the birth of the early Church in the Acts of the Apostles, and concludes with the prophetic vision of Isaiah, often nicknamed "the Fifth Gospel."

How It Works:

- Part One: Read One Psalm per day. There are 150 Psalms, so this creates a 150-day foundation of praise, lament, and thanksgiving.
- Part Two: Each day, also read—One chapter of the Gospels in order Matthew, Mark, Luke, then John followed by One chapter per day of the Acts of the Apostles, and finally Two chapters per day from the Book of Isaiah, whose vivid prophecies point to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This plan blends prayer and study into a daily spiritual rhythm, drawing the heart into the fullness of Scripture — the psalms that Jesus prayed, the Gospel story of His life, the Acts of His early Church, and the prophetic words that foreshadowed His coming. and it follows an organized 150 day cycle matching the rhythm of the 150 psalms.

How did I come up with this scripture plan? I realized that apart from daily Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours, I wasn't inviting enough time with God's word in my day. I prayed about a way to incorporate a simple daily habit of additional scripture prayer time that I could recommend to anyone! Praying about the best order with the cleanest rhythm, I came up with this in prayer and started this past week. I welcome you to do the same!

"Helping Others in Need"

This holiday season we will have several opportunities to help others in need in our community. There are currently 135 families who depend on help from our SVDP Foodbank to help feed their families. With the current government shut down, funds are limited to help programs such as the Food bank. God has asked us to make use of our time, talent and treasury to help others in need and during this upcoming holiday season, we ask that you share some of your blessings with others. Here is how you can help —

November – donations of paper products such as paper towels, Kleenex tissues and toilet paper will be collected and distributed to families as needed. Donations can be placed in the back of the church or dropped off at the Seton Parish Center during business hours. Paper products are not eligible to be purchased with food stamps and your donation will greatly help these families stretch their dollars.

December - we will once again sponsor the Holiday Dinner Tote collection for the 135 families. Sign up sheets will be placed in the back of church or contact the Parish Office at 724-864-6364 and sign up for how many bags you will be able to donate. You are asked to purchase a reusable shopping tote (.99 cents) and fill it with non-perishable items that the family can use towards their holiday meal. Items such as instant potatoes, canned vegetables, box of holiday cookies, coffee/tea/hot cocoa, applesauce, holiday napkins, candy are examples, and include any items that you enjoy at your holiday dinner. The tote bags will need to be brought to Mack Hall of St Eliz Ann Seton on Dec 8, 9 or 10th (remember Dec 8th is a holiday so you will be coming to mass and can drop it off). All bags must be dropped off by Dec 10th to

`ensure we have enough for all families. Please be sure to use a reusable shopping tote and not a plastic bag. The tote is easy for distributing to the families and for them to carry to their car.






