

Pastor's Reflection

Re-Calibration for Prayer at the pace of the Holy Spirit!

When I begin to experience tension or a lack of focus in my prayer—especially when it lasts for several days—I ask myself four simple questions. I call them my **“re-calibration questions.”**

It is easy to become spiritually misaligned, particularly when life is busy. If I answer *yes* to any of these questions, it is usually a sign that I need to adjust my prayer life and make a few intentional corrections to return to the pace of the Holy Spirit.

1. Have I eased up too much on a good practice I once had?

(Have I allowed a good spiritual habit to slip away?)

Solution: Bring this to prayer and intentionally re-engage that good habit.

2. Am I fast-forwarding through my day?

(Am I mentally rushing through my responsibilities—and even through my prayer time?)

Solution: Re-anchor yourself in the present moments and pray from where you are.

3. Am I creating my own rewards?

(Am I focusing more on earthly comforts or purchases rather than allowing God to provide spiritual joy?)

Solution: Consider a *no-spend day*. Plan ahead, avoid any unnecessary purchases or online browsing, and use that time for prayer instead.

4. Am I overemphasizing one part of my day while allowing other things to diminish?

(For example, too much work and not enough prayerful contemplation.)

Solution: Re-adjust your daily plan so that prayer, work, and rest remain in a holy balance.

Cemetery Manager

Full time manager will oversee cemetery operations which include, but are not limited to, overall cemetery grounds maintenance; arrange for footer, head stone, and plaque installations; grave management, which includes being able to coordinate with office personnel and funeral directors, excavating and back filling of graves, opening and closing of graves; opening and closing of the chapels for services, direct funeral processions, and accurately record and file paperwork; grass cutting at cemetery and snow removal at all parish and cemetery grounds; schedule contractors when necessary, and other inquires. Applicants MUST have a mechanical background, good communication skills, have a valid driver's license, be reliable and be conscientious. Although being Catholic is not necessary for employment, applicants should have an understanding and appreciation of the Catholic faith and its rituals. Applicants are reminded that, if hired, will be employees of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Greensburg. Before starting employment, applicants are REQUIRED to undergo and successfully complete all necessary trainings and obtain all necessary clearances to comply with the Diocese of Greensburg's call to Higher Standards, which include, but may not be limited to, background checks and fingerprinting.
