Pastor's Reflection

We need to ask our Father for what we need every day!

Why is this important? Why doesn't God just do the things I need to support me? I already pray everyday. -- Sure, God does feed us with the Manna that we need regularly but there is something pure and good about asking our Father for what we each need today! It's not selfish, its relationship. It doesn't mean I get what I ask for, it means I trust our Loving Father with my daily request!

Fr. Jim---can you give me two reasons why I should start to do this prayer?



1. It focuses us out of trying to guess what we think God wants to hear from us and helps us develop a more trusting relationship with our Father in Heaven.
2. It also allows the Father to form us in what we are asking Him. Only He can truly feed us and we can't know how to ask Him for what we need without daily prayerful practice!

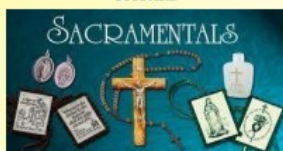
