Pastor's Reflection

Lent; the problem with Sin and a remedy for Discouragement!

The problem with sin is that it makes us trust God less. We have all heard that sin effects the whole community; not just ourselves. You have probably thought that this doesn't seem true. You might say to yourself, "If I let out a few swear words when I'm alone, and no one hears it, then it did not affect the body of Christ (the community around me) *No one heard it!* Swear words are just a small example but let me explain why this is wrongful thinking. While there are varying levels of sin, all sin hurts my relationship with God. It does so because when I sin, I automatically start to trust God less. The effect of sin is my trust in God diminishes. This is especially true with selfishness (any sin that makes me turn inward) This affects who I am to the Body of Christ. In the Story of the Fall of man, when Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit, they were no longer the same. They didn't yet have the sacraments to be restored. This was the first separation of humanity's relationship with God. They immediately saw God differently and with less trust and an unholy fear. They began to hide from him. Willing that human beings not remain in this state forever, God set a plan in motion, chose a people and formed them over time for the purpose of preparing for a new Adam; *The Christ* who would repair this relationship of God and humanity.

Lent is the gift of journeying with the *New Adam*, Christ our Lord, into the desert to be set free of all the lies that cling to us in our distractions. What's the most common lie we all hear within us; "God doesn't care about me, He seems so far away and uninterested in my problems." This is called *discouragement* and it's the biggest enemy to our peace. Discouragement is one of the more powerful methods of the enemy. Discouragement can make us want to give up our Lenten fast before we even start and listen to the lies that it doesn't matter anyway. Those lies vanish like passing smoke when we repent and choose to invite our Lord into our lives every day. *Fasting* supercharges this repentance! Try this prayer next time you feel discouraged. (Perhaps this lent!) It's an example of an "Arrow Prayer" that cuts through that cloudy weight of discouragement.

"By your Holy Face Lord Jesus Christ and by your most precious blood, I reject these thoughts of discouragement, and I ask for your Mercy upon me." I Love you Lord Jesus, help me to love you more!"

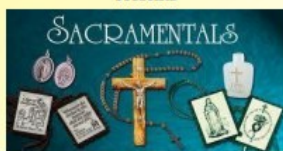

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast & abstinence

Fasting - (Ages 18-59)

Three total meals on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent. (One main meal and two smaller meals). The two smaller meals should be equal or lesser to the main meal for ages 18-59.

No snacking. Exemptions: any special health condition/need, temporary or permanent, takes precedent over the practice of fasting from food --please use your judgement and discern wisely! You should choose something other than food to fast from in those special circumstances.

Abstinence from Meat (Ages 14 +)

No Meat. Allowed: Fish, eggs, dairy products & condiments.
