



Pastor's Reflection

Think of **Raking** the earthly Leaves in your soul that have accumulated throughout the year:
Restrain, Ask, Keep, Empty.



Restrain throughout the week from spending any money on yourself other than for essential things like food, medicine, family needs or charitable contributions. AKA *Fasting* from personal purchases or non-essentials.

Ask the Lord in prayer about your day in a quiet place. **Ask** why certain things happened (joyful or stressful) and try to prayerfully answer those same questions. I find that when I ask the Lord these questions and prayerfully try to come up with an answer... The Holy Spirit provides clarity that I didn't have a few moments ago. What do I ask the Lord about? -- I **Ask** about the things that are most memorable when I enter quiet prayer--That's the Holy Spirit serving those things to us for prayer.

Keep a Lenten faith journal and make a note of any memorable good thing that the Lord provided for you each day that stood out to you as a blessing. Right just one blessing per day this lent - each that were specific to that day! Make it a challenge!

Empty your earthly concerns for some time. Make a daily prayer walk if the weather permits. Prayer walking or exercising in general is a great example of mortification of the flesh. Perhaps combine this with a rosary or pray a rosary in a quiet place if you can't take a walk.

Fasting - (Ages 18-59)

Three total meals on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent. (One main meal and two smaller meals). The two smaller meals should be equal or lesser to the main meal for ages 18-59.

No snacking. Exemptions: any special health condition/need, temporary or permanent, takes precedent over the practice of fasting from food --please use your judgement and discern wisely! You should choose something other than food to fast from in those special circumstances.

Abstinence from Meat (Ages 14 +)

No Meat. Allowed: Fish, eggs, dairy products & condiments.




