



Pastor's Reflection

Every Catholic needs some good Catholic spiritual reading every day for lent!

Here are my 5 best tips to follow through with this exercise!

1. Look around first for any book you have received or bought and have not yet read! --You know those ones that are sitting on the shelf that someone gave to you or that caught your eye and you purchased but haven't started them yet?
2. Pick one that seems like it fits that good catholic category and read only that book until it is finished.
3. Use the treasure hunting method for daily reading. What's that? --Read only enough pages until you find the treasure (=One thing you didn't know yesterday or hadn't thought of quite like that before about the Faith) that's your daily treasure! -Usually takes about 3 or 4 pages for me ☐
4. There are easy Catholic books and challenging Catholic books. Both have their purpose. Both are good as long as they are seeking to promote the Holy Catholic Faith! I read more challenging books slower and let the Holy Spirit do *His* job to help me contemplate the fruits.
5. If you have no unread books on hand... search online for a good Catholic book. Here is the key: Pick the least expensive one that seems to fit the category and purchase that one. Feel free to check the reviews but don't overthink it. As long as it is promoting the Faith. Purchase the least expensive one and let that be your Lenten book for treasure hunting.


