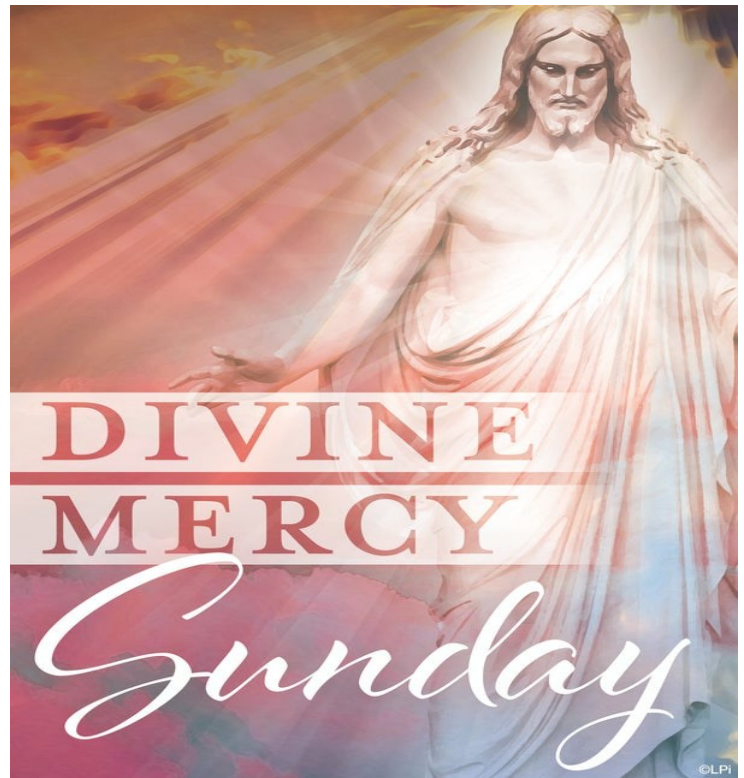

Pastor's Reflection

Divine Mercy Sunday: What Is It—and Why Should I Care?

Divine Mercy Sunday was given to the Church by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000 during the Jubilee Year. He did not invent this devotion, but his deep connection to Saint Faustina Kowalska helped bring renewed attention to the Lord's abundant mercy at a time when the world needed it—and still does.

So what is God's mercy?

At times, it can feel confusing. One saint may speak in a way that makes holiness seem almost impossible; while another says that the greatest sinner is most deserving of God's mercy. So which saint is right?

In truth—they all are.

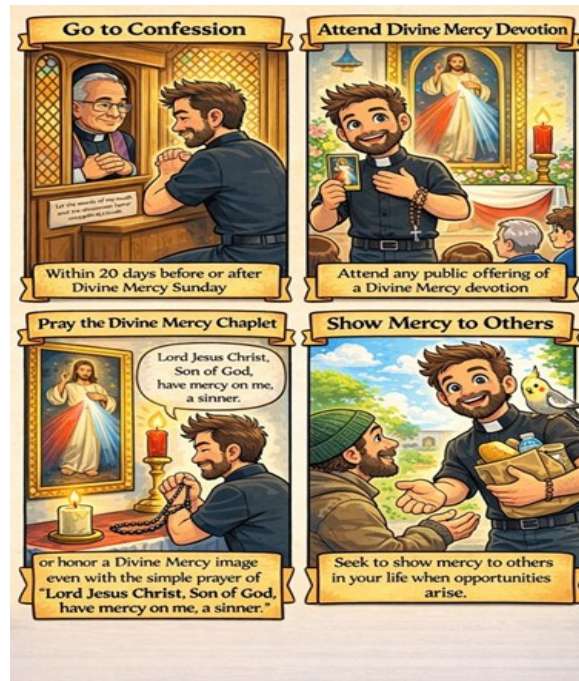
The saints speak from their own journey of surrender to God. He does not will that everyone express the faith in exactly the same way. Rather, He works with each of us gradually, guiding us closer to Him over the course of our lives and giving us great Saints in every generation to encourage us in the Faith!

When you look at the saints, they come from different backgrounds, experiences, and struggles. There are similarities—because the same God is at work—but they do not all emphasize the same part of the path to holiness.

Saint Faustina was given a particular mission: to focus on and proclaim God's abundant mercy during a time when the world was in great need of it—and we certainly are today as well!

So this Sunday, take some time to reflect on God's love and forgiveness. Embrace it. Start anew if you need to. Or simply take a break from overthinking your path to holiness. Let more of the Holy Spirit's Will enter your plans—and a little less control of your own.

- **Go to Confession** (within a reasonable time (20 days) before or after Divine Mercy Sunday)
- **Receive Holy Communion** on Divine Mercy Sunday
- **Pray** (especially the Divine Mercy Chaplet if you can!)
- **Practice Trusting in Jesus** — *"Lord Jesus, I Trust in You"*
- **Show mercy to others when opportunities arise**
