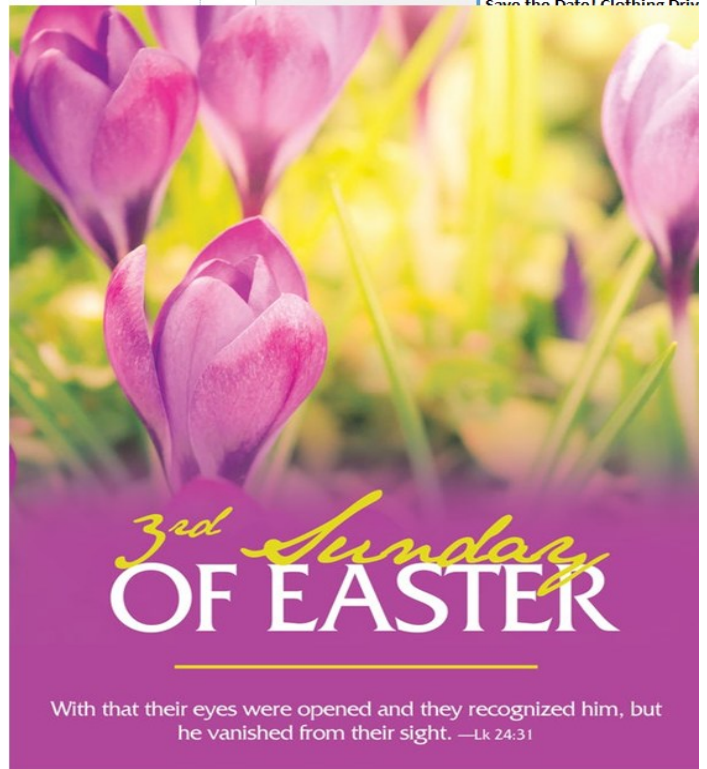

Pastor's Reflection

Do the readings at Mass sound interesting or difficult for you?

First, what am I supposed to get out of the readings at Mass, especially when they start to sound the same during Easter? Should I just sit there quietly and wait for the greatest part of the Mass—Our Lord in the Eucharist!? It's great to look forward to the Holy Eucharist and that is the whole reason for the Mass. (But) Receive all of it first. Especially God's word proclaimed. During this season the Church gives us the Acts of the Apostles every day because it shows what happened after Jesus rose and ascended—the earliest life of the Church, with all its preaching, confusion, courage, and the guidance of the Holy Spirit. It's a completely unique book, a bridge between the Gospels and the rest of the New Testament, helping us understand why the Church looks the way it does today.



But when it begins to feel repetitive or even boring, that's where a shift helps. Scripture is not written to grab our attention the way modern things do; it works much more quietly and deeply. At Mass, you are not there to figure everything out or feel inspired every time. You are there to receive the word patiently and prepare for Christ in the Eucharist. So if it doesn't seem interesting or clear, don't overthink it—just listen and let it be given to you. The Word of God works more like a seed than a spark. It is planted, often unnoticed, and over time it begins to grow. You don't have to understand every reading; you simply have to let God speak, trusting that the Holy Spirit will bring it to life when the time is right.

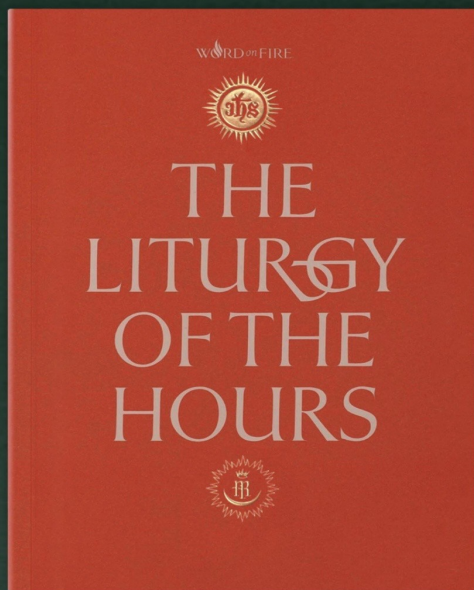
