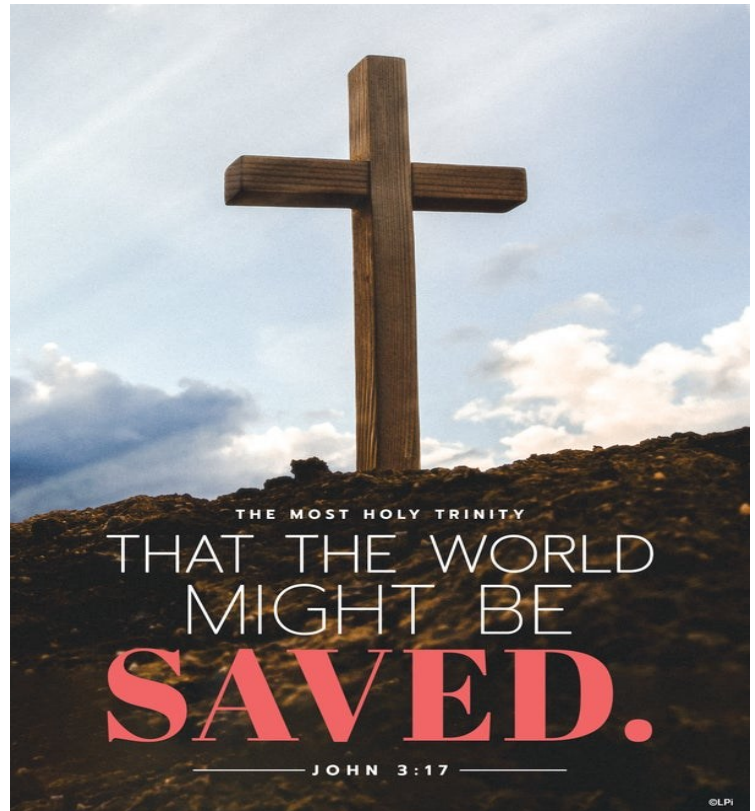

Pastor's Reflection

The Holy Spirit supports us in prayer which produces fruit all around us. The more attentive you are to prayer, the more people and situations around you begin to experience the sweet effects of the Holy Spirit. It's a 20 minute opportunity for daily conversion to the Lord's Will by the help of Blessed Virgin Mary and most certainly the Holy Spirit. It is by the Holy Spirit, that the Blessed Mother conceived our Lord Jesus. As we pray in the Hail Mary; "Blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus; we are most certainly giving our focus to the greatest work of the Holy Spirit, the Incarnation! So, if you're wondering how to love and ask the help of the Holy Spirit for your life, you cannot go wrong with praying a daily rosary!

For all of you who already pray a daily rosary: I offer a tip for praying the mysteries of the Rosary more fruitfully: Try speaking to one of the Holy Person's in each mystery, as you open the mystery, instead of just naming the title of the mystery. Use your imagination.

Examples below using the Joyful Mysteries.

Mystery 1: The Annunciation: "Blessed Mother Mary, you were visited by the Angel Gabriel, who announced that you would receive the Son of God in your Womb."

Mystery 2: The Visitation: "Blessed Mother, you traveled to meet your cousin Elizabeth, who's infant leapt in her womb at the sound of your arrival."

Mystery 3: The Nativity: "Lord Jesus, you were born into the world for us- from the most Holy Womb of your Mother, under the protection of Saint Joseph."

Mystery 4: The Presentation: "Oh Saint Joseph, you carried the Christ child into the temple with Mary and presented Him to the Father."

Mystery 5: The Finding of Jesus in the Temple: "Lord Jesus, you somehow stayed behind when the caravan of people left on their journey. A day and a half in, Mary and Joseph realized you were not there! They were struck with great anxiety, and they traveled in haste to find you a day and a half's journey back! There, they found you in the Temple! Help me to find you again when I have lost your direction in my day."

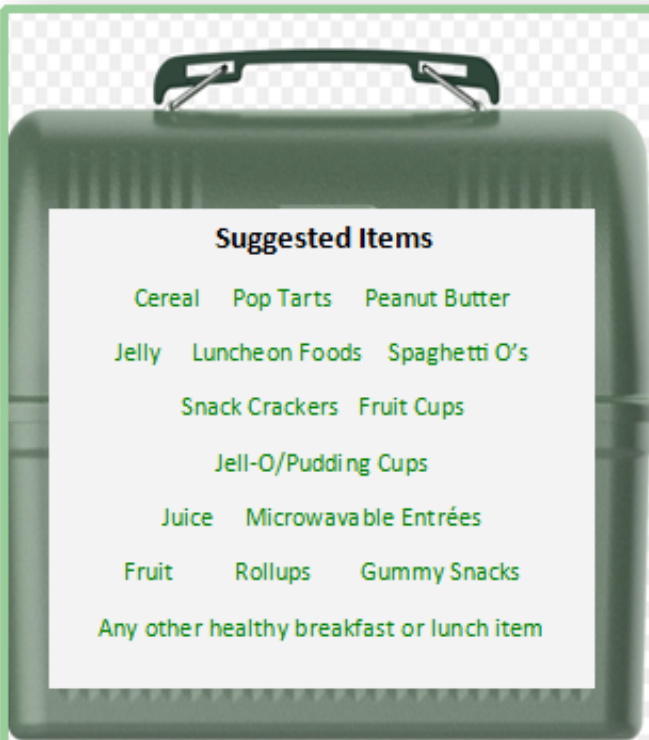
