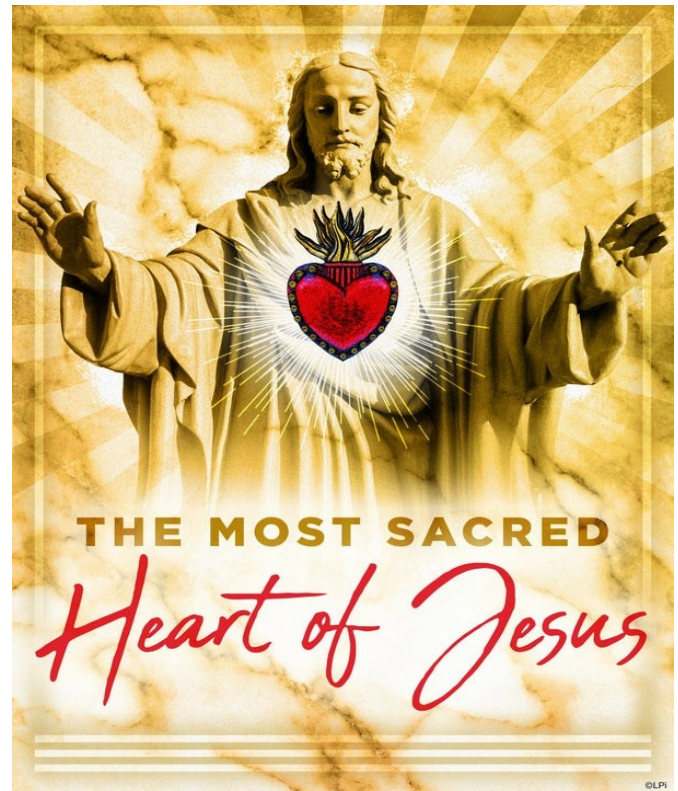

Pastor's Reflection

How do I pass through what seems ordinary in the appearance of bread and wine at Holy Mass into the infinite mystery of the Body and Blood of our Lord that I receive? Is this a matter of discipline or pure holiness? Answer: Both. Holiness comes from discipline. How? I must actively do what is within my power to do to prepare for the greatest gift God provides. This is a daily thing. It's too easy to treat this gift like any other thing in my life. If I treat the Eucharist like any other passing thing it will be experienced to me as just another passing thing. Why? God does not force our reception of His gifts. He forces nothing on us we don't want. (But) He allows the effects of a lack of His support to be felt. I experience worse days with more problems when the Eucharist is the last thing on my mind. I lose the clarity of the Holy Spirit and the support of the Lord's favor. It is a gift to experience these negative effects so that we turn back to the One who provides, just as Israel had to re-learn often in the Old Testament. When the Eucharist is properly placed as most important in my day-I gain the favor of the Lord's clarity back. Why would anyone choose a worse day? We do this by the effects of original sin; distractedness, lack of trust that God will provide, lack of resistance to sin, lack of patience and discipline; all of which are disordered effects of *The Fall*. So, what are three things I can start to re-engage daily that are purifiers of my weaknesses and direct me back to what matters most? (The Eucharist!)

1. One hour with no phone in quiet before my Lord everyday. (If not able to be in front of the tabernacle for this-use a prayer corner space at home and split up the hour into 20 or 30 min blocks)
2. Practice Holy Mass Disciplines for your Soul using your physical powers. You have real power. Laziness is the rejection of my God given powers. Example: If I kneel, stand and sit in a holy way within my ability throughout the Mass focusing ONLY on this discipline itself - acting attentive; things will change for the better in my life. Discipline leads to good things.
3. If you struggle to make it for one hour a day in quiet with God, break it into 3 blocks of 20 and get the 20 minutes a day down as a habit, work only on that until it is a firm daily commitment. If you struggle to pray the Rosary or read the Gospels in this time-try this prayer in your quiet time: "Lord, I don't know what to say to you, have mercy on me, a sinner." Repeat that 12 times - one for each Apostle and it will be a good form of prayer to begin your discipline time in quiet (Just use a timer).

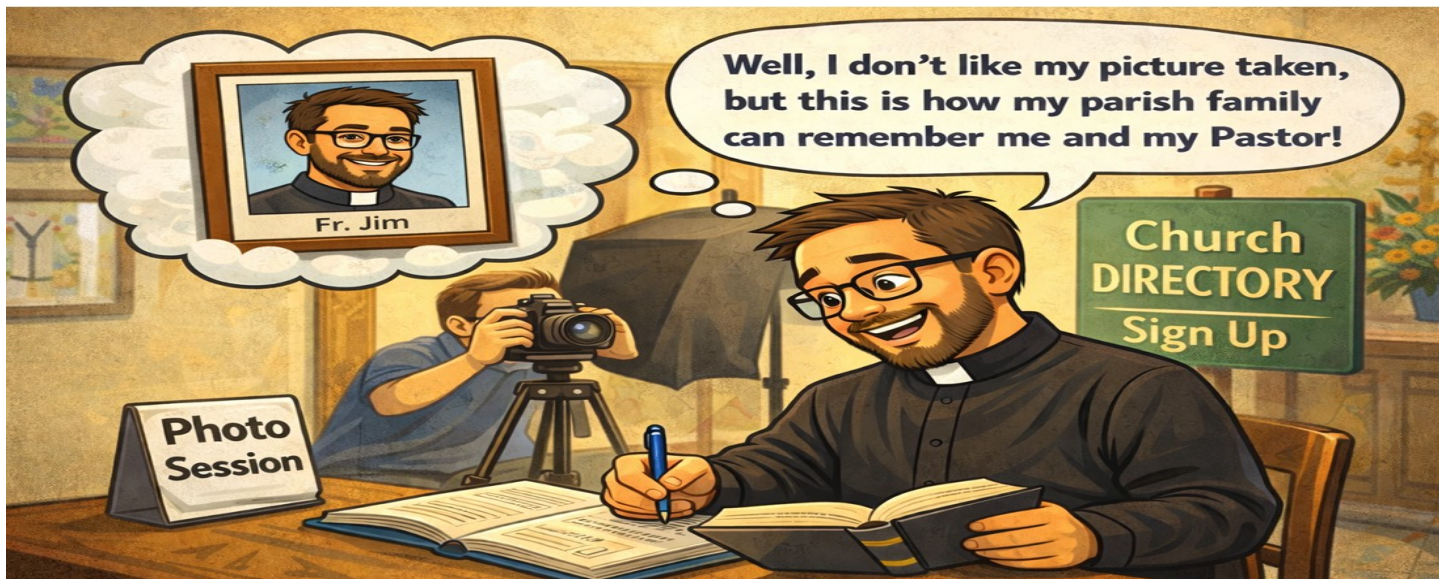

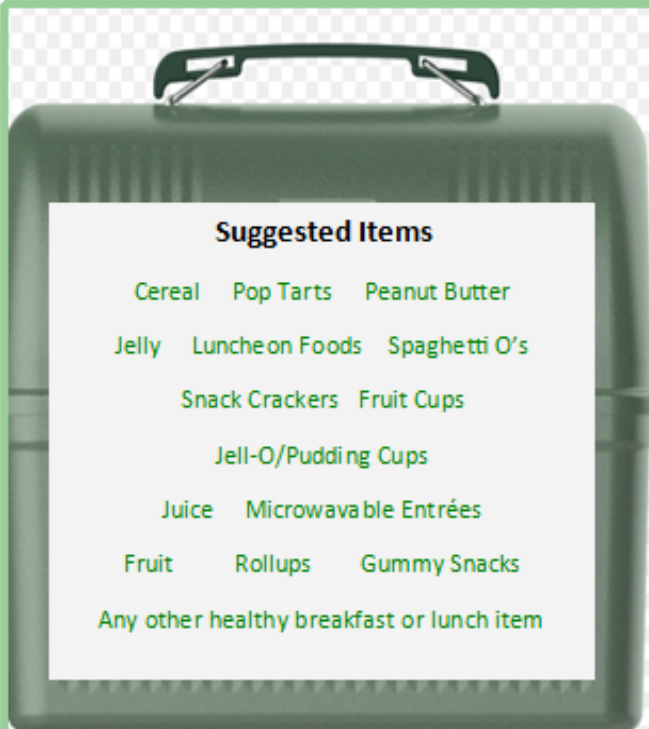

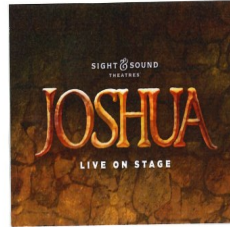
