# Pastor's Notes

Three words have the power to shape much of our prayer lives: "***I love you.***" Sacred Scripture tells us that *God is love* (1 John 4:8). It is not difficult to look at a parent, a child, a spouse, or a dear friend and say, "I love you." Those three words strengthen relationships, express affection, and reveal the deepest desires of the heart. Yet I have often realized that I do not say those same three words often enough to my Lord and my God. Ask yourself:

**Do I tell God that I love Him every day?**

Often when we begin to pray, we wonder what words God wants to hear from us. We search for the perfect prayer of our season in life or the right theological expression, but we should never forget the simplest and truest form of prayer: "*My Lord and my God, I love You.*" "*God our Father, I love You.*" "*Holy Spirit, I love You.*"

If God is love, what better words can I return to him who has first given me the *ability as a gift* to love anyone? With that same spirit, I'd like to offer a simple suggestion for praying the Holy Rosary. As you begin each mystery, picture the Gospel scene before you... Imagine yourself present with those who were there. Then choose one holy person in that mystery and simply say, "***I love you.***" Why? because they are friends of God who is love!

Of course, every mystery leads us to love Jesus and His Blessed Mother more. (But) speaking those words to another holy person in the scene can make the mystery feel more personal and more contemplative -- Below is an example from each set of mysteries:

- At the **Annunciation**, tell the Angel Gabriel, "*I love you.*" (*1st Joyful Mystery*)
- At the **Institution of the Holy Eucharist**, look toward Saint Peter and say "*I love you.*" (*5th Luminous mystery*)
- As Jesus carries His Cross, kneel before Him in your imagination and whisper, "*My Lord and my God, I love You.*" (*5th Sorrowful mystery*)

At the **Resurrection**, imagine meeting Saint Mary Magdalene and saying, "*I love you.*" (*1st Glorious mystery*)

You can do this with every mystery of the Rosary. Place yourself within the Gospel scene, choose one of the holy men or women present, and let those three simple words become an act of love as your prayer to God. This small practice has helped me pray the Rosary more attentively and more prayerfully. I hope it may do the same for you.

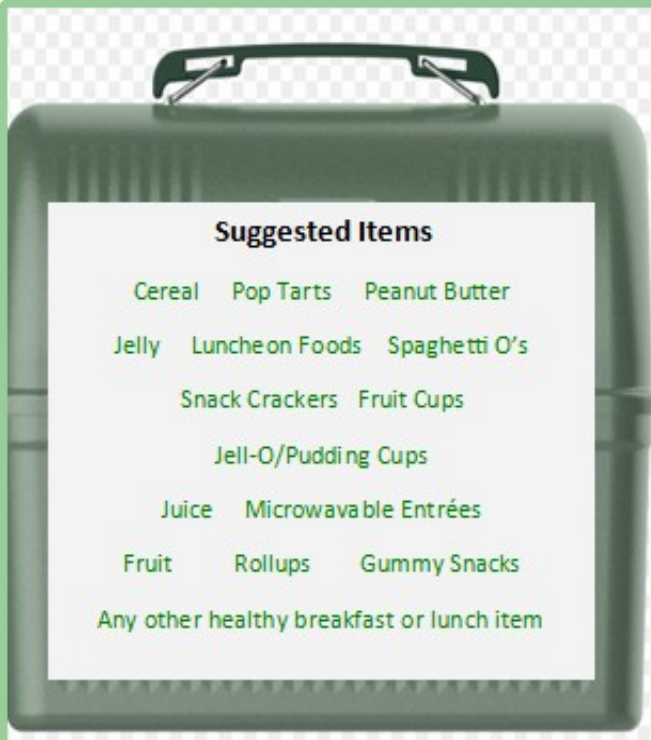
