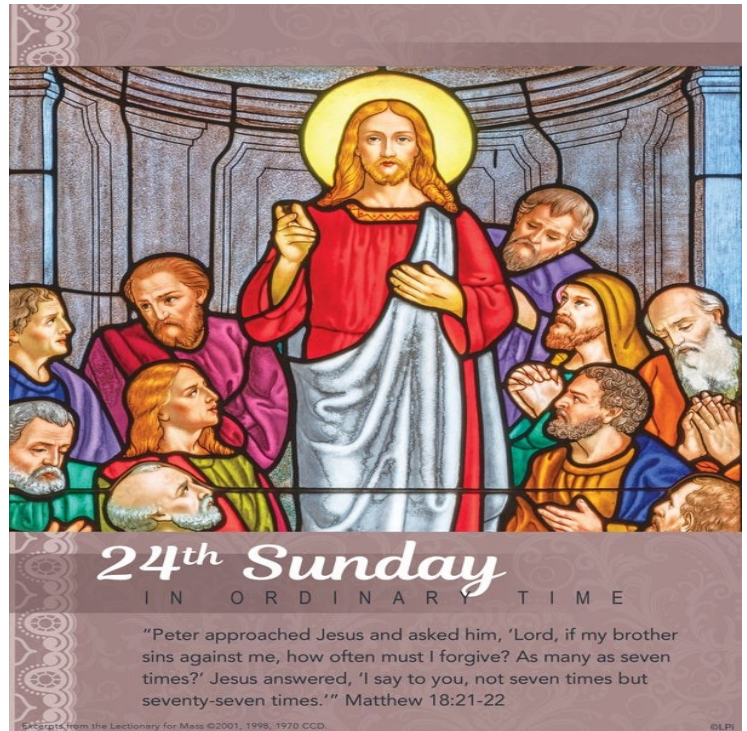

Pastor's Notes

The New Testament. How did we get it?

The New Testament gives us the Good News, the Gospel of Jesus Christ, crucified and risen from the dead, and the fulfillment of God's promise to draw humanity into a new and everlasting Covenant with Him.

A promise foreseen by the prophets of the Old Testament.

The books of the Old Testament already existed and formed the Scriptures of the Jewish faith into which Jesus was born according to God's plan. Jesus knew these Scriptures, quoted them, prayed them, and fulfilled them.

But when Jesus walked the earth, the New Testament did not yet exist. The Gospels, the letters of Saint Paul,

Acts and Revelation had not yet been written.

First came Jesus Christ Himself. Then came the Apostles, their preaching, the life and worship of the early Church, and the handing on of what Christ had taught them. From within that living apostolic Church, the books that we now call the New Testament were gradually written during the first century. Later, the Church formally recognized which of those writings belonged to the inspired collection we now call the Bible.

But how did the Church discern this?

The Bishops of the early Church did not simply sit down and choose the books they personally liked best. Rather, they collectively recognized and discerned the writings that were already being handed on, copied, read, preached from, and used in the worship of Christian communities. They had to consider whether a writing came from an Apostle or someone closely connected to the Apostles, whether it was widely received and used by Christian communities, particularly in worship, and whether its teaching was consistent with the apostolic faith the Church had already received from the Apostles and had been teaching.

This process took time. Some books were accepted very early and widely, while others were debated in different parts of the Christian world. Eventually, through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the Church formally recognized the books that belonged to Sacred Scripture. The Church did not make these books inspired; The Holy Spirit did that. Rather, the Church was given the responsibility of discerning and recognizing which writings God had inspired and entrusted to His people. That collection of inspired writings is what we now hold in our hands and call the New Testament conclusion to the Word of God we call the

Bible.
