Pastor's Notes

Always check the basic things first. A very common difficulty for Catholics who experience new seasons of tension in their lives is that they panic. Using myself as an example, I get rattled easily and go too far trying to figure out God: Why has He removed His favor? What progress have I failed to make that He is angry with me about? What am I neglecting that is stirring up the wrath of God? I don't say it out loud like that, but I inadvertently begin thinking in those terms.

Now, as a priest who falls into these traps regularly, let me help you—and myself—overcome these false questions. The solution is surprisingly simple: When God is not providing what you have grown used to, and your season of life has gotten noticeably more tense, always check the basics first.

What are the basics? Go into prayer in front of the tabernacle and think about the last time you experienced God's favor. What was your daily prayer life like then? Have you started skipping things that were good for you? Perhaps you were making 30 minutes a day unwaveringly in silent prayer, and you started skipping it because work got harder. Perhaps you were talking to Jesus about your life every day, and you simply stopped because you got tired of it.

There is one thing I am sure of: the best *filter* to check and see if it needs attention is your time with God. Not words—time. Let's use an example. If you were praying two Rosaries a day for four months and it just wasn't feasible to continue that form of prayer, don't necessarily return to two Rosaries just yet. Instead ask yourself: What did I replace those 22 minutes with that used to be my second Rosary? If the answer is, "Well, surfing the internet for golf gear," or anything else—hold that thought. God doesn't miss your words.

He misses your time!

That's a human way of saying it, but it resonates with us. God is Love and the source and sustainer of our life, and by His amazing mystery, He wants to spend time alone with us. And it is the easiest thing to skip. Why? Because He doesn't demand it like other people in our lives do. He calls through signs and internally, through the whisper of the Holy Spirit. But we feel it when we have backed away from quality time with our Father. And there are so many ways we can use that time. We just have to be alone with Him and seek to know Him. In my experience, the negative effects of spending less time with God don't show up right away, it takes a few weeks or longer for God is patient with us. Good habits are hard to form and bad habits are hard to break.

But let's check our basics today!

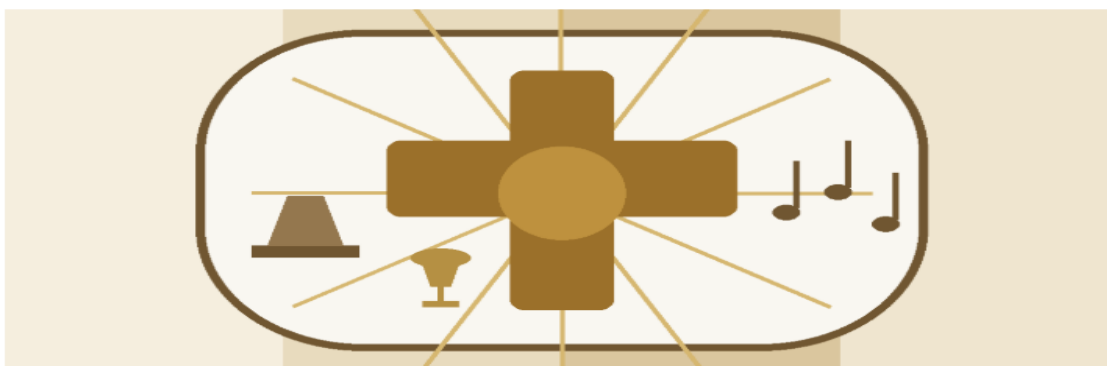
