Pastor's Notes

Make One Gospel Your Prayer Book This Month

The Gospels of Jesus Christ are amazing—and yet, I probably spend less time simply praying with them than I do with almost any other form of prayer. Granted, priests don't promise to pray the Gospels daily like we do the Liturgy of the Hours but this is a real need to know our Lord. There is something different about sitting with Christ's own words, watching what He does, noticing how He communicates with people, and allowing ourselves to remain there with Him...to Hear Him daily.

But here is the problem I sometimes encounter—maybe you do too. I open the Gospels to pray, and almost immediately I think, *I already know this story*. Or I get the feeling that I should be doing something else—something more structured, more productive, or somehow more “prayerful.” If you experience that, push back against that idea like I need too.

The Gospels are for prayer. They are not a classroom book for the semester to complete.

Of course we study them. We learn theology from them. The Church is formed by them. We hear them proclaimed at Mass. But Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John are also places where we encounter Jesus Christ. We don't need to analyze every verse or figure something out. We just need to spend time in them. So here is my challenge for September—Join me if you like!

Choose one Gospel; Matthew, Mark, Luke or John (Only One) and make it your prayer book for the September.

Continue praying your daily Rosary or other foundational prayers important to your life but perhaps replace some of those *extras* with a Gospel! And stick with that one Gospel. It is your prayer book. Don't worry about finishing it. Don't worry about how many chapters you read. **Read slowly enough that when something catches your attention, you can stop.** Stay there. Talk to the Lord about it. Listen. Let yourself become familiar again not merely with a Gospel story, but with **Jesus Himself**.

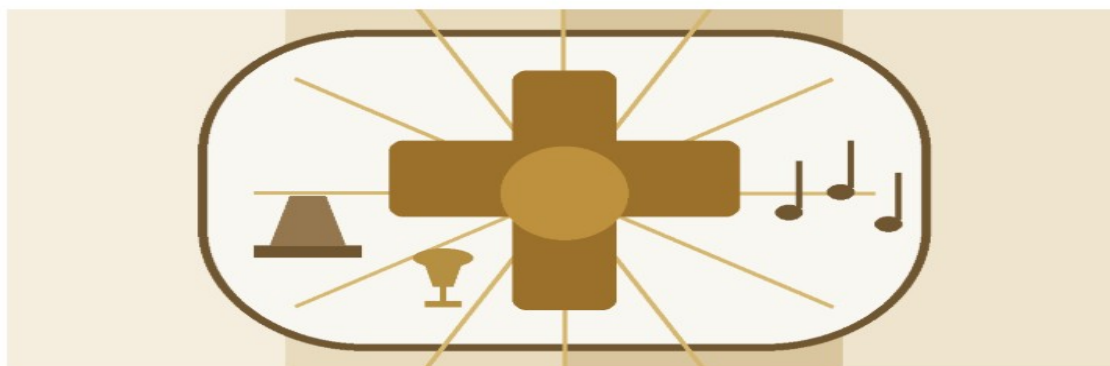
